| <b>23. Santa Cristina Chianti Superiore</b> <i>Tuscany, Italy</i><br>A classic Chianti, offering aromas of red berry fruit, with vanilla and floral hints of violets. | <b>24. Prunotto Barolo</b> <i>Piedmont, Italy</i><br>Complex nose with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits. Delicately floral, perfumed yet persistent on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.  |                      | <b>£55.00</b> |
